Conditions of disposal (Extract)

- Bidders must adhere to & observe ACSA site access conditions during viewing.

- The vehicles will be sold "voetstoots" (as is).

- Bidders must submit proof of Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) contributor verified in accordance with the codes of the Dept. of Trade & Industry (DTI) from a SANAS approved rating agency. For EMEs (Turnover below R5m) with no B-BBEE certificate, a certificate/letter from a registered accountant/accounting officer will suffice.
- Bidders must submit an Original & Valid Tax Clearance Certificate.
