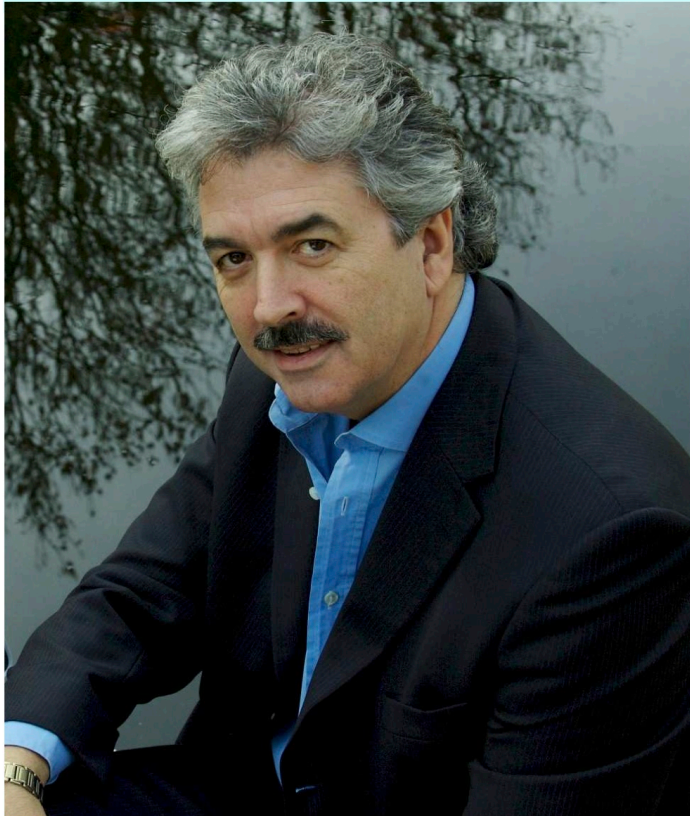

Eight Times World Memory Champion

Chronological Biog

- 1988 Started memory training aged 30
- 1989 First entry in Guinness Book of Records memorisation of 6 shuffled decks of playing cards
- 1991 Became the First World Memory Champion in October
- 1992 WMC event not held this year
- 1993 Won WMC for second time
- 1994 Silver medal in WMC. First book 'How to develop a perfect Memory' Voted 'Brain of the year' by the Brain Trust of Great Britain
- 1995 Won WMC for third time. Second book 'How to Pass Exams'. Guinness book of records 40 shuffled decks of playing cards.
- 1996 Won WMC for fourth time. Guinness entry 1 deck of cards in 38.29 Secs
- 1997 Won WMC for fifth time
- 1998 Did not enter WMC. Developed Super Memory Power 12 audio cassettes 4 books. Launched Super Memory Power as a 20 part monthly course
- 1999 Won WMC for sixth time
- 2000 Won WMC for seventh time Book 'Learn to Remember' BestSeller Blackjack course 'Winning Hand' 3 videos, 1 audio cassette, 2 manuals
- 2001 Won WMC for eighth time. Guinness record on German TV. Memorised 2 decks of cards at the same time in 3 min 53 seconds. No errors. Quantum Memory Power, CD course, Nightingale Conant. Launched 'The Amazing Memory Box'
- 2002 New World Record. Memorised 54 decks of cards. Won head to head in Tokyo against the Japanese Memory Champion. Silver medal at the WMC
- 2003 Revised edition of 'How To Pass Exams' Start new company <http://www.peakperformancetraining.org/>
- 2004 Development of ebook, 'How To Develop a Perfect Memory'
- 2005 New book 'How To Develop a Brilliant Memory' Presented with Lifetime Achievement Award at WMC 2005
- 2006 Consultant with BBC for their season on memory. Regular slot on new Sky Entrepreneur Channel. Features in "Braintrainer" US and Canada.
- 2007 Feature Feb 20th BBC2 8pm "Don't Die Young". Now working with Lenny Henry on performance training.
- 2008 Co-founder and Chief Coordinator of The World Schools Memory Championships and Chief Executive World Memory Sports Council
- 2009 Teaching memory to teachers and students in school nationwide

Daren Denholm has been the highest ranked competitor at the World Memory Championships from Africa and the Southern Hemisphere from 2006 - 2011. He has also been the only person in the world to have competed in all 6 World Memory Championships during this time, arguably making him one of the most experienced competitors on the international circuit. (Out of over 450 people from 42 countries) In the past 8 years Denholm has personally taught over 125 000 people from 15 countries how to radically increase their memory, speed of learning and concentration.
