ANIMALLY HAVEN

Another initiative of our collaboration with ZEMA is to not only live out the humane perspective of Mandela day but also fulfil the need animals have and the responsibility and leadership we have towards animals.

The name 'Animally' is derived from the word 'family', which the founder, Gianna Scoulelis, created to suit her 'family of animals', hence 'Animally Haven'.

Most of Animally Haven's residents have either been too badly abused to be re-homed, or they have been passed from pillar to post too often, or they were hours away from being put to sleep because they couldn't be homed.

With 25 pigs, 50 cats, 18 dogs, 5 puppies, 3 birds, 2 Guinea Pigs, 1 rabbit, 1 rat and 1 mouse, it is admirable that Gianna has been able to provide a safe haven for so many animals with little help from the public – currently the NPO is 90% self-funded.
