



PUBLIC NOTICE: TO ALL TOURISM BUSINESSES WITHIN THE PROVINCE OF KWAZULU-NATAL

The Department of Economic Development and Tourism hereby issues a notice in terms of the regulations promulgated in May 2004, under section 32 (f) and (i) of KwaZulu-Natal Tourism Amendment Act, 2002 to remind all tourism businesses to register and, or renew their registration with the Department of Economic Development and Tourism.

The Act stipulates that it is mandatory for enterprises whose primary objective is to provide services and facilities to tourists in the province of KwaZulu-Natal to register their businesses, and may not provide services in the tourism sector unless registered with the relevant authority, in this case the Department.

The Department of Economic Development and Tourism hereby appeals to all tourism establishments and tour Operators (tourism businesses) within the province of KwaZulu-Natal to register with the Department through Provincial Registrar, and further requests those tourism businesses that have not renewed their registration to do so **ON OR BEFORE THE 30th OF NOVEMBER 2013** to ensure compliance with policy stipulations.

The registration of tourism establishments and tour operators is mandatory for the following categories

:

- ✍ **Accommodation**
- ✍ **Travel Services**
- ✍ **Conference Venues**
- ✍ **Historical/ Cultural Centres**
- ✍ **Recreation and Entertainment Attractions**

All tourism businesses are urged to ensure that they have submitted relevant documentation necessary for the registration process prior to making any payments to the Department.
